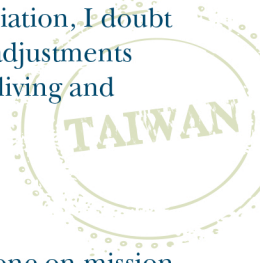


BENEFITS OF OUR PROGRAM

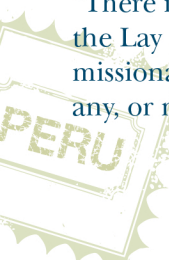
